  - a. What is the basic question or research area?
  - b. Why is this an important topic?
  - c. What relationship does this project have to your course background in political science at Brown University?
- 5. Email agreement from your advisor who must be a <u>faculty member in the political</u> science department.
- 6. Email agreement from your second reader.
